Child Find Notice:

It is the responsibility of the Newburyport Public Schools to identify any child who is a resident of Newburyport, or who attends a private school in Newburyport who may have a disability. It is also the responsibility of the Newburyport Public Schools to evaluate those students to determine if they are eligible for special education or related services under IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) or 603 CMR 28 (Massachusetts Special Education Regulations).

Newburyport Public Schools is committed to identifying children before their third birthday in order to provide early intervention services for three and four year-olds. If you have questions or concerns regarding your child's development and would like to have him/her screened, please call Lori Morasse at Francis T. Bresnahan Elementary School for an appointment at (978) 465-4435 ext. 3125.

If you suspect that your child, at any age, may need an evaluation to determine eligibility for special education services, you may request an evaluation, at no cost, at your child's school.
